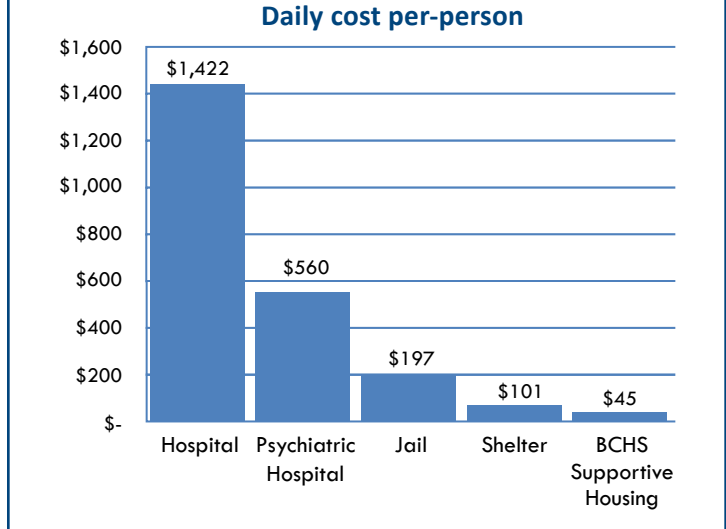




**BCHS programs prevent homelessness** for more than 1,000 at-risk children, women and men each year.

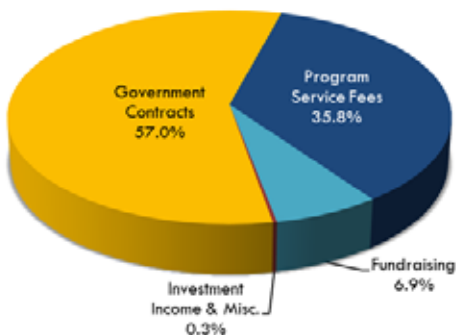


BCHS provides significant savings to tax-payers because supportive housing at BCBS is much less expensive than alternatives.



- The *Arbor Inn* program for homeless mothers with children **placed 100% of housing ready homeless families into permanent housing** in the community this past year.
- BCBS' newest initiative, *The Brooklyn Housing Assistance Center*, **successfully prevented evictions for 100% of the over 400** Brooklyn households that sought our help this past year.

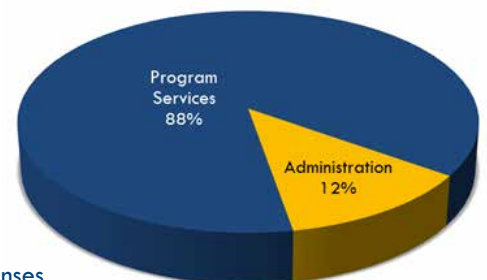
- BCBS **provides supportive housing for 412 formerly homeless individuals each day.** We opened new permanent housing in 2012, and are working to develop two additional housing sites to be opened in the coming years.
- BCBS' **unique program model** has been studied by government and non-profit officials from throughout the U.S., the United Kingdom and Australia.
